Focus on: LASIK

LASIK is the most popular elective surgery to correct eyesight. The procedure involves using a highly specialized laser to reshape the cornea – the transparent layer covering the front of the eye – to better focus light on the retina and improve vision. LASIK is used to correct the most common vision problems, such as nearsightedness, farsightedness and astigmatism. LASIK is associated with rapid visual recovery. And whats more there is little pain other than slight pressure during the procedure and some discomfort for a few hours afterwards.

A Unique Approach to the LASIK Procedure

Dr. Rabinovitch uses an incredibly precise laser to create a thin, hinged flap on the surface of the eye to allow the Excimer Laser to reshape the tissue below. While some LASIK procedures simply reshape the cornea based on a standard prescription, each of Dr. Rabinovitch's patient treatments is completely personalized – just like a fingerprint.

This custom LASIK combines topographical analysis, Femtosecond laser and advanced Excimer Laser technology to create a correction map based on the unique characteristics of each eye. Your individualized treatment plan will then be applied to your cornea with precision and HD accuracy. The tiny flap is then brought back into place and serve as a natural bandage. Within minutes the procedure is over.

What is Wavefront Technology?

During LASIK surgery, a laser is used to reshape the cornea, eliminating irregularities that cause vision problems like nearsightedness, farsightedness and astigmatism—also known as lower-order aberrations. Traditional LASIK surgery cannot detect corneal irregularities that cause highorder aberrations such as halos and glare. Custom LASIK treatment employs wavefront technology which gives us the ability to pinpoint the exact cause of these irregularities and correct them.



How it works

- Makes a detailed 3-D map of the surface of the eye
- The mapping data is transmitted to a computer program that guides the laser in correcting the higher-order aberrations
